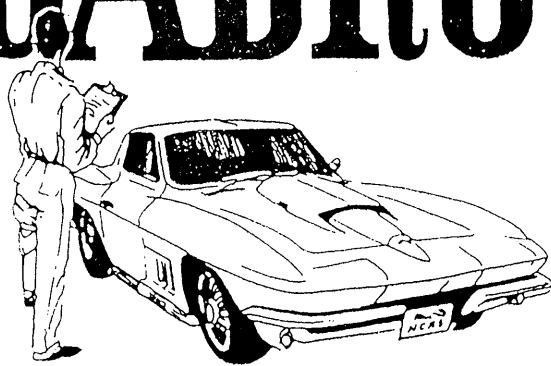

Meeting:

Date: December 12, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM by our president, Billie Pyzel at the home of Rick and Ida Lise Jones.

Guests introduced were Skip and Corliss Burroughs from Arizona, the Jones' house guests, Paulina Van Veen, Rick's mother, and Amber Reif and her friend Joey.

The minutes from the November meeting were approved as published in the newsletter on a motion by Fritz Allen; seconded by Jim George.

Eli Maestas reported a balance of \$3271.58 in the chapter account. There was no buck in the box this time, however Steve Walker had donated a Corvette art print by Dana Forester. This was raffled off, and was won by Jack Barnett. Proceeds from the raffle totaled \$250.00, which was donated to the chapter to help defray initial expenses for our upcoming Regional.

Membership and website were discussed. Our total membership still stands at about 75, which is at the division between small and medium chapters. About a third of the members have renewed, and the renewal forms will be mailed out in the next few weeks.

Under Old Business, a brief discussion was had about the 2010 Western Regional. Fritz reminded everyone that some of the jobs on the task list still are unclaimed, and the floggings will continue until all tasks have at least one volunteer. An appeal was made for the members to come up with items for the swap list. Those with birthdays in November and December were acknowledged, and the phone committee was announced consisting of Tabot Smith and Doug Bird. A discussion was held about how to encourage more participation by our Santa Fe members. It was agreed that we should have several meetings in Santa Fe to promote this, and Bill Wilhelm agreed to discuss this idea with Tim Alton.

Under New Business, the elections were held. Since the previous board were nominated and had accepted, and there were no new nominations from the floor, the previous board members were reelected by acclamation. The first three meetings of 2010 are a judging school at RMCi in January, a breakfast meeting at the Range Café on Menaul in February, and a meeting in Santa Fe in March.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Fritz Allen and second by Jim George. The Christmas party then began. We all stuffed ourselves, and the gift exchange was held in a very restrained and dignified manner, in deference to the Jones' home and contents. No bloodshed or broken bones were reported.
