
We will also serve a complimentary "Hobo Dinner" of hot dogs and beans for our vendors and volunteers, on the north field at 6:00pm on Friday evening.

Turn right (south) and go about 1½ miles to Morris Road, on the right (west). Turn right on Morris Road to enter Swap Meet vendor entrance and public parking area. Follow direction signs.
