You think you've got fuel problems!....a tech tip

On the way back from our Chapter Meet at Farnsworth Chevy two years ago our 1967 Corvette ("1 Owner" – so blame me for the problem), the car started backfiring and was very hard to keep running on the Thruway trip from Exit 44 to 45. I had no idea what the problem could be . . . new everything, including fresh 93 Octane with Lead Additive and Octane Boost to about 103.

When I parked her on my lift, I began to check things out. First thing, the car had trouble re-starting. Had to pump the throttle way too much, and when she ran, it was an uneven idle. Next I checked the fuel filter, and it was "a bit varnished". The real give-away was the fuel tank. It was the second tank installed during my 10 year rebuild between August 1988 and August 1998, going back on the road at 114,091 miles. It had had a lot of the "real gas" through it, and when the leaded stuff left the pumps for the most part, I simply used the 93 Octane -10% ethanol mix with Octane Boost.

Well, that "new fuel" sucked all the (up to then – harmless) varnishes off the inside of the tank, and it was "still new metal but covered with black gunk deposits. A quick removal of the carb bowels revealed the same stuff up at the front end of the car.

Time for action. I called Quanta and got a correct new tank. Next I got really hassled at a local Auto Parts store trying to only buy the exact length "ethanol safe" rubber fuel line footage I needed. They would not split an even foot of length, and it cost me about \$12 extra. I had to power flush the metal fuel lines with a good cleaner.

I sent the original carb to Holley for a factory complete restoration, and included all new jets, new gaskets, etc. that could now handle ethanol. An exact rebuild of the fuel pump was also in order, and I was told it would also not be deteriorated by the new fuel.

My plan was to rebuild keeping the car looking extremely original, yet allow it to be safely driven without further fuel issues imposed by our friendly Federal G-men. For fuel, I mixed 8.3 gals. of 93 Octane Ethanol 10% with a full can of Torx and boosted the Octane to 106. I added a little Marvel Mystery Oil to add lubrication, plus 8 oz. Of TK-100.

The whole job topped out at about \$1,066, and we ran the car 81 miles that year. Instant start, no lag after idle, excellent acceleration, and normally poor fuel mileage. (That's a story for another day!!)

Moral of the story . . . if you are having some performance concerns, backfiring, lag on acceleration, poor idle, etc. . .look in your tank first.

A flashlight may tell the whole story!!
